3. Purpose of data processing

The purpose of data processing is the registration process to organise the training and the realization of the training itself. Registered participants will have their e-mail addresses added to the HPDA 2022 training mailing list for communication and information purposes.

An additional purpose of the processing is the collection of aggregate participant statistics. In order to make the learning experience even more sustainable and to disseminate the training contents to prospective users of HPDA and visualisation well beyond the registered participants, the online training will be recorded and published via the ESIWACE web page, the ESIWACE YouTube feed or similar means. Participants who do not wish to appear in the recording must leave their camera switched off and their microphone muted. Participants who do not want questions to be published are free to contact the presenters after the training sessions via standard means of communication.

4. Legal basis of data processing

The legal basis of data processing for event organisation is the contract that is concluded with us upon registration (Art. 6 Abs. 1 lit. b GDPR).

If you have consented to this, the legal basis for the collection of participant statistics is precisely this consent (Art. 6 Abs. 1 lit. a GDPR).

The legal basis for processing in these instances is Article 6, para. 1, lit. f GDPR (legitimate interests of the controller).

5. Data recipients and categories of data recipients

The registration data are collected and used within DKRZ and in collaboration with the ESIWACE2 partners at CMCC¹ for the sole purpose of organising and realising the Training on High Performance Data Analytics (HPDA) and Visualisation, which will be held as a virtual event in September, 2022. The training is being organised by the ESIWACE2 partners at CMCC with support from DKRZ.

Your full name and institute affiliation are required for the registration. The training workshop will be held using the videoconference software Zoom².

During the training, questions from the audience will be collected in editable Google Docs on Google Drive accessible via a public URL. Presentation slides of the trainings will be made publicly available on the on the ESIWACE website at <https://www.esiwace.eu>.

The video recordings of the event will be made publicly available via YouTube and/or similar means.

After the event, aggregate data without personal reference may be used for documentation, dissemination and communication purposes. The data is not passed on to third parties.
