3. Purpose of data processing

4. Legal basis of data processing

The legal basis of data processing for event organization is the contract that is concluded with us upon registration (Art. 6 Abs. 1 lit. b GDPR).

If you have consented to this, the legal basis for the collection of participant statistics is precisely this consent (Art. 6 Abs. 1 lit. a GDPR).

The legal basis for processing in these instances is Article 6, para. 1, lit. f GDPR (legitimate interests of the controller).

5. Recipients and categories of recipients

The registration data are collected and used within DKRZ for the sole purpose of organizing and realizing the workshop.

Your name and e-mail address are required for registration. The slides of the presentations will be made publicly available on the DKRZ website <https://indico.dkrz.de>. After the event, aggregate data without personal reference may be used for documentation, dissemination and communication purposes.

A passing on of data to third parties does not take place.

6. Storage duration

The data collected during the registration process will be stored until no later one year after the respective talk. The agenda, including names and affiliations of speakers as well as presentation titles and slides will be permanently available on the DKRZ website.

7. Rights of data subjects

You have the right to obtain information on the data stored about you by DKRZ, the right to demand correction in the event of incorrect data or deletion in the event of unauthorised data storage, and the right to data transfer. You also have the right to appeal to the supervisory authority.
